#### **Previous minutes**

1. The minutes of 22 March 2022 were agreed.

#### **Business Programme**

- 2. The Bureau agreed a revised programme of business for the week commencing 28 March 2022, and programmes of business for the weeks commencing 18 and 25 April 2022.
- 3. After the Minister declined requests from Stephen Kerr and Neil Bibby to include a statement from the First Minister on ferry procurement in the week's business, Stephen Kerr and Neil Bibby reserved their party's positions on the revised programme of business for w/c 28 March 2022.
- 4. The Bureau agreed that Members Business on Tuesday 19 April would be S6M-02795: Jeremy Balfour: Welcoming the Down Syndrome Bill; on Wednesday 20 April would be S6M-03367: Joe FitzPatrick: Sexism in Football, and on Thursday 21 April would be S6M-02902: Katy Clark: Keeping CalMac Public and Publicly-Owned Ferry Services.

## Timetabling of Bills

- 5. The Bureau agreed to recommend to the Parliament that consideration of the Non-Domestic Rates (Coronavirus) (Scotland) Bill at Stage 1 be completed by Friday 29 April 2022.
- 6. The Bureau agreed to recommend to the Parliament that consideration of the Fireworks and Pyrotechnic Articles (Scotland) Bill at Stage 1 be completed by Friday 6 May 2022.
- 7. The Bureau agreed to recommend to the Parliament that consideration of the Hunting with Dogs (Scotland) Bill at Stage 1 be completed by Friday 30 September 2022.

### Approval of SSIs

 The Bureau noted that, subject to the Social Justice and Security Committee recommending approval of the SSI at its meeting on Thursday 31 March, a motion to approve the Social Security (Up-Rating) (Miscellaneous Amendment) (Scotland) Regulations 2022 (SSI 2022/Draft) would be taken in the Chamber on Thursday 31 March.

#### Time for Reflection

- 9. The Bureau noted that, after Easter recess, Time for Reflection will be delivered in person with the option of contributors still being able to pre-record their contribution if that is their preference.
- 10. The Bureau also agreed for the Presiding Officer to finalise contributions to the programme for April-June 2022, including any adjustments due to contributor availability.
