Previous minutes

1. The minutes of 14 March 2023 were agreed.

Business Programme

- 2. The Bureau considered a programme of business for the week commencing 20 March and a revised programme of business for the weeks commencing 27 March and 17 April 2023.
- 3. Neil Bibby requested statements on the Junior Doctors strike and cladding and the Scottish Safer Buildings Accord.
- 4. Alexander Burnett supported these requests. He also reiterated statement requests on the Children's Orchestras Funding U-turn and the Teacher Pay Deal and requested a statement by the First Minister's on the Ministerial Code and statements on Dentistry and the Deposit Return Scheme.
- 5. The Minister for Parliamentary Business indicated that the Government would consider the requests and respond in due course.
- 6. Alexander Burnett reserved his party's position on the revised business programme.
- 7. The Bureau agreed that Members' Business on Wednesday 29 March would be Liam Kerr: S6M-07327: Scotland's Courts Maintenance Backlog. The Bureau also agreed that the SNP Members' Business debate scheduled for Thursday 30 March would be postponed until after recess.
