PARLIAMENTARY BUREAU: SUBSTITUTION ON COMMITTEES

Substitution on Committees

- 1. Standing Orders provide that a political party represented by 2 or more members of the Parliament may nominate a member of that party to be a substitute (referred to as a "committee substitute") for the members of that party on a committee. Further provision is made that a member cannot be a committee substitute for more than two committees at the same time.
- 2. Scottish Labour are seeking to nominate Committee substitutes. A list of these substitutes can be found at the end of this paper.
- 3. The Bureau is invited to agree to lodge a motion to propose these changes and that the motion be taken on Wednesday 22 September.
- 4. Should any other Business Managers wish to nominate substitutes or make changes to committee membership to be taken in a motion on Wednesday 22 September, they should provide a note of these nominations to the Business Team by close of play Tuesday 21 September.

- 10. The Bureau is invited to consider the above and—
 - to propose to the Parliament the Labour substitutes noted in this paper;
 - to provide any other committee membership changes and substitutes in writing to the Business Team and other business managers by close of play Tuesday 21 September; and
 - for business managers to agree by correspondence on the full raft of membership changes and substitutes to be included in the motion taken on Wednesday 22 September.
