PARLIAMENTARY CALENDAR: OFFICE OF THE CLERK AND CHRISTMAS RECESS

Christmas recess

- 1. The Parliament has previously agreed that—
 - the Christmas recess begins this year on Friday 23 December 2022 and ends on Sunday 8 January 2023; and (<u>Motion ref. S6M-04616</u>)
 - the Office of the Clerk is closed on Friday 23, Monday 26 and Tuesday 27 December 2022 and Tuesday 3 and Wednesday 4 January 2023. (Motion S6M-01333)

2. Since 2000, the Bureau has additionally proposed that the Office of the Clerk be closed between Christmas and the New Year. The Bureau is therefore invited to agree to propose to the Parliament that the Office of the Clerk be closed this year on Wednesday 28, Thursday 29 and Friday 30 December 2021 as shown in Annexe A. Questions, motions and amendments cannot be lodged when the Office of the Clerk is closed and the impact of the proposal on some of the deadlines for lodging are discussed below.

3. Additionally, there was a minor error in motion S6M-1333, which did not specify that the Office of the Clerk should be closed only on the afternoon of Friday 23 December. It is therefore proposed that the closure of the office of the Clerk which was previously agreed to by Motion S6M-01333 is adjusted to become a closure of the afternoon only.

Impact on deadlines – Parliamentary questions

4. This has an impact on some of the deadlines which would normally apply on a Monday (the deadlines for submission of names for the ballots for Portfolio and General Questions and the associated deadline two days later for the lodging of questions). Proposed deadlines which take this and recess dates into account are set out below and shown at Annexe B.

Topical Questions – Tuesday 10 January 2023

5. The deadline for lodging a question would be 12 noon on Monday 9 January 2023 (this is the usual arrangement).

Portfolio Questions – Wednesday 11 January 2023

6. For Portfolio Questions on 11 January 2023, names to be entered into the draw should be submitted no later than noon on Monday 19 December 2022, with questions being submitted no later than noon on Wednesday 21 December 2022. This follows the pattern in previous sessions.

General Questions – Thursday 12 January 2023

7. Deadlines for the submission of names and questions for General Questions are the same as those for Portfolio Questions (above).

First Minister's Questions - Thursday 12 January 2023

8. The deadline for lodging a question would be 12noon on Monday 9 January (this is the usual arrangement).

Portfolio Questions – Wednesday 18 January 2023 and General Questions – Thursday 19 January 2023

9. For Portfolio Questions on 18 January 2023, names to be entered into the draw should be submitted no later than noon on Monday 9 January 2023, with questions being submitted no later than noon on Wednesday 11 January 2023.

10. Deadlines for the submission of names and questions for General Questions are the same as those for Portfolio Questions (above).

Impact on deadlines – motions and amendments

Motions for debate - Tuesday 10 January 2023

11. If a debate on Tuesday 10 January requires a motion, the deadline would be 10.00am on Monday 9 January and for lodging amendments to that motion would be 4.00pm on that Monday (these are the usual arrangements).

Motions for debate – Wednesday 11 January 2023

12. The deadline for lodging motions for debate on Wednesday 11 January would be 4.00pm on Monday 9 January and for lodging amendments to these motions would be 4.00pm on Tuesday 10 January 2023 (these are the usual arrangements).

Conclusion

13. The Bureau is invited to—

- agree to propose to the Parliament by motion that the Office of the Clerk be closed on Wednesday 28, Thursday 29 and Friday 30 December 2022; and
- consider the proposed deadlines set out above.
