# PARLIAMENTARY BUREAU: APPROVAL OF SCOTTISH STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS

### AFFIRMATIVE INSTRUMENTS

Cost of Living (Tenant Protection) (Scotland) Act 2022 (Amendment of Expiry Date) Regulations 2023 (SSI 2023/Draft)

1. Under Rule 10.6.5, the Bureau is required to lodge the following motion—

George Adam on behalf of the Parliamentary Bureau: That the Parliament agrees that the Cost of Living (Tenant Protection) (Scotland) Act 2022 (Amendment of Expiry Date) Regulations 2023 (SSI 2023/Draft) be approved.

## **Purpose**

2. To extend Part 1 of the Cost of Living (Tenant Protection) (Scotland) Act 2022 for a further, and final, six-month period from the end of 30 September 2023 to the end of 31 March 2024, at which time Part 1 of the Act will expire. Provisions within Part 1 include a 3% rent cap; a Prescribed Property Costs safeguard which private landlords can apply to a rent officer for increases of up to 6% to help cover certain cost increases incurred over the preceding six months; some eviction orders approved by the First-tier Tribunal not being enforceable for six months and continued application of increased damages for unlawful evictions of up to 36 months' worth of rent.

## Consideration by committee

3. At its meeting on 12 September 2023 the Local Government, Housing and Planning Committee agreed to recommend (by division: For 4, Against 2, Abstentions 0) that the regulations be approved. The <u>Committee report</u> was published on 13 September 2023.
