<u>Social Security Information-sharing (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2024</u> (SSI 2023/Draft)

1. Under Rule 10.6.5, the Bureau is required to lodge the following motion—

Purpose

2. To amend existing provisions that are contained in the Social Security Information-sharing (Scotland) Regulations 2021 regarding the sharing of information obtained by the Scottish Ministers in connection with their social security functions. The amendments provide that such information may be shared with local authorities and the Public Guardian for further specified purposes set out in the instrument's Policy Note.

Consideration by committee

3. At its meeting on 7 December 2023 the Social Security and Social Justice Committee agreed to recommend that the Regulations be approved. The Committee report was published on 13 December 2023.
