Scottish Government submission of 23 November 2023

PE2055/A: Stop the exportation of live animals as a priority

The Scottish Government is committed to banning live exports of animals for fattening and slaughter, and to only allow live transport of livestock to and from Scottish islands and the mainland with stringent welfare standards in place. We therefore welcome the UK Government's announcement that it will introduce a bill to ban live exports and will now work jointly with the UK Government and other devolved administrations to implement this.
