The Terminally III Adults (End of Life) Bill Legislative Consent Memorandum

Thank you for your <u>response to the Committee</u> in relation to Clause 43 (Prohibition on advertising – regulations to prohibit advertisements promoting a voluntary assisted dying service) of the above Bill, which it considered at its meeting of 7 October.

The committee agreed to report to the lead committee considering the Scottish Government's Legislative Consent Memorandum ("LCM") at its meeting, but also agreed to ask you to keep it updated on the development of the drafting of any amendments to the prohibition on advertising in the bill, which you indicated was underway.

The Committee hopes to hear from you ahead of the Committee stage in the House of Lords, scheduled for Friday 14 November.
