Dear Edward,

As you know, following the successful passage of the Climate Change (Scotland) Act 2009 (Scotlish Carbon Budgets) Amendment Regulations 2025 last month, I have now laid the draft Climate Change Plan and delivered a statement in the Scotlish Parliament. This outlines how the first three carbon budgets will be met, covering the years 2026-2040.

As you are aware, this begins 120 days of scrutiny, which will be completed on 5 March 2026. The public consultation period on the draft Climate Change Plan will run for 12 weeks in total. Since the consultation will be an iterative process, I remain confident that the next Climate Change Plan will be finalised during this Parliament following consideration of the feedback received.

The public consultation can be found here. It is open until 29 January 2026.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your work on this matter so far, and for all that is to follow over the coming months. I look forward to working with the Committee on the Plan to agree our path to a fairer, greener Scotland as part of a just transition to net zero.
