## PETITION PE1758: END GREYHOUND RACING IN SCOTLAND

At its meeting on 20 April 2022, the Rural Affairs, Islands and Natural Environment Committee considered the public petition <u>PE1758: End greyhound racing In Scotland</u> submitted by Scotland Against Greyhound Exploitation (SAGE). The petition calls on the Scottish Parliament to urge the Scottish Government to put an end to greyhound racing in Scotland.
