Sea Fish (Prohibition on Fishing)(Firth of Clyde) (No 2) Order 2022 (SSI 2022/35)

During the Committee's consideration of the Sea Fish (Prohibition on Fishing)(Firth of Clyde) (No 2) Order 2022 (SSI 2022/35) on 9 March 2022, you and your officials committed to writing to the Committee with additional information regarding the following:

- The scientific data which informed the decision to prohibit fishing activity in the Firth of Clyde, particularly the literature relating to the behaviour of spawning cod.¹
- What consideration has been given to wider spawning grounds when deciding on offshore wind sites?²
- Details of the publicly funded organisations involved in the co-management process who campaigned for the removal of the exemptions.³
