## 3. Presentation – The Nazareth Trust

June 14<sup>th</sup>, there will be a reception for the Trust to celebrate its 160<sup>th</sup> anniversary hosted by Jackson in Holyrood.

- <u>Dr Morgan Jamieson MBE</u>, Chair The Nazareth Trust-a constituent of Jackson's.
- Retired NHS Consultant
- Started in Edinburgh and Constantinople
- 1841 Foundation of Edinburgh Medical Missionary Society founded
- 1861 Dr Vartan establishes the clinic in Nazareth
- 1866 EMMS agree financial support
- 1904 EMMS funds the purchase of 25 acres of land on a hillside of the city
- 1912 First hospital building completed

- 1924 Nazareth Academic School of Nursing Inaugurated
- Now in collaboration with a Jewish College in Afula, so nurses can now train to a graduate level. Nurses now go other hospitals in and outside of Israel
- 1861-WW1 Ottoman Empire
- British Mandate
- 1948 State of Israel-establishment of a healthcare system
- 2012 The Hospital receives the Knesset award, the fist non-Jewish organisations to receive the award for valued contribution to the nation
- Since 1990s the entire staff is Israeli
- Currently have over 700 staff, is recognised as a major UK employer in Israel
- The Nazareth Trust established 2001
- Volunteer program-Serve Nazareth
- Nazareth Village
- <u>Professor Dr Fahead Hakim</u>, Nazareth Hospital Director-heard from him at the last CPG meeting, was a paediatric consultant in the past.
- Welcomed all to visit Nazareth
- Integral part of wider hospitals in Israel, serves over a half a million people
- Main acute care facility, cath lab, stroke unit, trauma, ER sees 70,000 people a year. Rambam in Haifa sees 140,000
- Only facility in the area that deals with Mental Health
- Specialises in dialysis
- Only facility in Nazareth at a world standard to have a IVF Unit
- 30% of patients are not Arab
- Recognised by the WHO as a Health Promoting Hospital
- Affiliated with Bar Ilan University and Tzfat
- Awards from the Ministry of Health
- #1 NICU, School of Nursing, People Satisfaction and Infection Control
- Only lab during COVID that was running 7 days a week
- President of Israel visited in December 2021
- Questions
- What can Scotland do now to help with the practicalities of the trust?
  - 1. Private hospital, no formal backing
  - 2. Look to the Government for help but look to international partners for capital support
  - 3. Budgets were half during covid, so support from abroad
  - What impact has the Amnesty Report had on the hospital
    - 1. Covid gave an opportunity to work together
- The future and the possibility of developing closer links to Scotland and Israel-links between medical students
  - 1. Serve Program
  - 2. Can plan towards June when they visit

- How reach students as part of scholarship program and how can support further
  - 1. Happy to engage with budgeting scholars
- 4. Embassy Update Oren Marmorstein, Deputy Ambassador, Israeli Embassy London
  - Introduced himself & his background
  - Abraham Accords- R&D fund with the UAE, trade deals, Embassy in Morrocco, warm peace
  - Iran is the biggest challenge for Israel; immediate concern is the nuclear issue
  - Iran is a global problem
  - Trying to build something bottom up for the Palestinian people
  - Helping Gaza
  - UK trade deal-only 3% for Scotland and wish to grow it

## Questions:

- Is the stability of the Accords at any risk, how solid do we feel is the relationship? Does the public support the accords?
  - o The real test will be the time of war
  - o Saw challenges in Egypt
  - New relationships were tested in May 2021-new friends are serious in relationship with Israel
  - o Has the potential to change the Middle East
- Are you missing Bibi, wanting Trump back (Nobel Peace Prize), thoughts on Russia.
  - o Luckily enough we have stability now, everyone wants a stable government, we have a budget which we didn't have for two years.
  - This government is unique, compiled out of so many different sects and ideologies of Israel.
  - o Government not driven by ideology but by objective approach
