In section 2 of the Census Act 1920 (duty of Registrar-General to carry out census, and provision for expenses), after subsection (2A) insert—

“(2B) Instructions issued by the Registrar-General for Scotland under subsection (1) must include guidance making explicit, matters in respect of which—

- (a) particulars are required, and
- (b) refusal or neglecting to state particulars does not make a person liable to a penalty under section 8(1).”>

<Report on the impact of this Act on the census

- (1) The Scottish Ministers must, as soon as reasonably practicable after the completion of the first census under the Census Act 1920 following the coming into force of this Act—
 - (a) prepare a report on matters mentioned in subsection (2),
 - (b) lay a copy of that report before the Scottish Parliament.
- (2) The report under subsection (1)—
 - (a) must consider the implications of the changes to the census arising out this Act to the undertaking of the census,
 - (b) may make recommendations for changes to the undertaking of future censuses insofar as they relate to matters arising out this Act.>
