<“(4BA)The Scottish Ministers must, as soon as practicable after the payment under subsection (4B) has been made, but before they make any regulations under subsection (4C)—

- (a) carry out a review of the carer’s allowance supplement amount,
- (b) set out the conclusions of the review in a report, and
- (c) lay the report before the Scottish Parliament.

(4BB) The report must include the Scottish Ministers’ views on increasing the amount of the young carer grant (within the meaning of the Carer’s Assistance (Young Carer Grant) (Scotland) Regulations 2019) in a similar manner as the carer’s allowance supplement can be increased under subsection (4C).”.>

- 5 In section 1, page 1, line 11, at end insert—

<“(4BC)The Scottish Ministers must, as soon as practicable after the payment under subsection (4B) has been made, but before they make any regulations under subsection (4C)—

- (a) carry out a review of whether the amount of carer’s allowance supplement in respect of any carer with caring responsibilities for more than one person should be an amount greater than the amount calculated according to the formula in subsection (4),
- (b) set out the conclusions of the review in a report, and
- (c) lay the report before the Scottish Parliament.”.>

<Increased amount of carer’s allowance supplement until its replacement

In section 81 (carer’s allowance supplement) of the Social Security (Scotland) Act 2018, after subsection (4B) insert—

“(4BA) In each financial year from 2022/23 until such time as the carer’s allowance supplement is replaced by another form of carer’s assistance given by Scottish Ministers, the amount of a carer’s allowance supplement in respect of each period of 1 October to 31 March is double the amount calculated according to the formula in subsection (4).”>
