

Carer's Allowance Supplement (Scotland) Bill

Amendments in debating order

Group 1: Increased amount of carer's allowance supplement

- 6* In section 1, page 1, leave out lines 9 to 11 and insert—
- <“(4B) In respect of each payment of a carer’s allowance supplement until such time as the carer’s allowance supplement is replaced by another form of carer’s assistance given by the Scottish Ministers, an additional amount, calculated according to the following formula, is added to the amount calculated in subsection (4)—
- $$(((UCx12/52) - CA) \times 26) - (\text{the amount calculated in subsection (4)})$$
- (4BA) For the purposes of subsection (4B)—
- (a) UC is the amount of the standard allowance for a single claimant aged 25 or over as it would have been set out in regulation 36 of the Universal Credit Regulations 2013 (S.I. 2013/376) on 1 October 2021, where that standard allowance is to be read as if it was increased by £86.67, and
 - (b) UC is to be calculated according to paragraph (a) and then updated along with inflation until 2025.”.>

- <**Increased amount of carer's allowance supplement until its replacement**
- In section 81 (carer’s allowance supplement) of the Social Security (Scotland) Act 2018, after subsection (4B) insert—
- “(4BA) In each financial year from 2022/23 until such time as the carer’s allowance supplement is replaced by another form of carer’s assistance given by the Scottish Ministers, the amount of a carer’s allowance supplement in respect of each period of 1 October to 31 March is double the amount calculated according to the formula in subsection (4).”.>

- <**Increased amount of carer's allowance supplement until its replacement**
- In section 81 (carer’s allowance supplement) of the Social Security (Scotland) Act 2018, after subsection (4B) insert—
- “(4BA) In each financial year from 2022/23 until such time as the carer’s allowance supplement is replaced by another form of carer’s assistance given by the Scottish Ministers, each payment of carer’s allowance supplement is double the amount calculated according to the formula in subsection (4).”.>

<“(4BB) The Scottish Ministers must, as soon as practicable after the payment under subsection (4B) has been made, but before they make any regulations under subsection (4C)—

- (a) carry out a review of the carer’s allowance supplement amount,
- (b) set out the conclusions of the review in a report, and
- (c) lay the report before the Scottish Parliament.

(4BC) The report must include the Scottish Ministers’ views on increasing the amount of the young carer grant (within the meaning of the Carer’s Assistance (Young Carer Grants) (Scotland) Regulations 2019 (S.S.I. 2019/324)) in a similar manner as the carer’s allowance supplement can be increased under subsection (4C).”.>

<“(4BD) The Scottish Ministers must, as soon as practicable after the payment under subsection (4B) has been made, but before they make any regulations under subsection (4C)—

- (a) carry out a review of whether the amount of carer’s allowance supplement in respect of any carer with caring responsibilities for more than one person should be an amount greater than the amount calculated according to the formula in subsection (4),
- (b) set out the conclusions of the review in a report, and
- (c) lay the report before the Scottish Parliament.”.>
