[AS INTRODUCED]

An Act of the Scottish Parliament to amend section 2 of the Gender Representation on Public Boards (Scotland) Act 2018 to repeal the definition of “woman”.

1 Amendment of the 2018 Act

5 In section 2 (key definitions) of the Gender Representation on Public Boards (Scotland) Act 2018, the definition of “woman” is repealed.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after Royal Assent.

3 Short title

10 The short title of this Act is the Gender Representation on Public Boards (Amendment) (Scotland) Act 2024.
