The local authorities are listed in alphabetical order, followed by the name of the MSPs, their party and the constituency (C) or region (R) they represent.

The boundaries of local authorities and parliamentary constituencies do not coincide, so some constituencies overlap into two or more local authorities. Where this happens, the MSP representing the constituency will be listed under all relevant local authorities.

Similarly, where the boundary of a Scottish Parliament region overlaps into two or more local authorities, all the MSPs elected to represent that region will be listed under all relevant local authorities.
