## Session 3 MSPs Not Standing or Not Returned in the 2011 Election

MSPs: Historical Series

48 Session 3 MSPs were not returned to the Scottish Parliament in Session 4. They either did not stand as a candidate for re-election, or they stood but were not re-elected.

This fact sheet is divided into two sections. The first section lists those MSPs who stood for re-election but failed to win a seat. The second section lists those MSPs who were serving at the end of Parliamentary Session 3 (22 March 2011) but chose not to stand for re-election.
