## **REQUEST FOR INFORMATION: 2023-694464**

We acknowledge your request for a weekly breakdown of the non-operator data usage and 4G/5G data usage for parliament devices (mobile phone, iPads etc) owned by named MSPs between 19 December 2022 and 30 October 2023.

We wrote to you on 30 November 2023 to seek clarification of your request. Our letter advised that we do not hold information about data usage for devices owned by MSPs. We explained that we hold information about data usage for devices used by Members which are owned by the Scottish Parliamentary Corporate Body (SPCB). We also advised that we do not hold information in a format that would enable us to provide a weekly breakdown of data usage for the Members referred to and that we can provide this information on a monthly basis.

You responded on 30 November 2023 confirming that you are seeking this information for parliamentary devices and that you are content for this information to be provided on a monthly basis.

Your request has been handled in accordance with the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOI(S)A).

Please find attached a spreadsheet listing a monthly breakdown of data usage for each of the parliamentary devices used by the Members referred to in the request.

These data volume figures for the 19 MSPs requested reflects devices used by Members in carrying out their parliamentary duties.

All of the data figures shown were within roaming bundle limits, therefore, no additional charges arose to the public purse or to Members personally.

The Scottish Parliament does not hold information about non-operator data usage and therefore we cannot provide it to you.

In line with the technical requirements of FOI(S)A we have provided a notice advising that this information is not held by the Scottish Parliament.
