Cross-Party Groups – annual monitoring report

Introduction

1. The Standards, Procedures and Public Appointments Committee (the Committee) is responsible for overseeing the Cross-Party Group (CPG) system. As part of this role, it considers annual monitoring reports on Groups' compliance with the rules in Section 6 of the Code of Conduct for MSPs (the Code).

Compliance

- 2. The monitoring report covers the following rules that all Groups must comply with—
 - Groups are normally required to have at least five MSPs, with at least one MSP from each of the parties or groups represented on the Parliamentary Bureau but the Committee has previously agreed that there should be a general waiver of this Rule in the current Session and Groups are now required to have five MSPs from the majority of parties represented on the Parliamentary Bureau;
 - CPGs must hold at least two formal meetings per year, a formal meeting is a meeting where two MSPs, who are members of the Group, are present at the meeting;
 - CPGs must hold an AGM, within 11-13 months of the initial meeting, and each 11-13 months thereafter;
 - CPGs must submit an annual return form within 30 calendar days of the AGM;
 - CPGs must provide Standards Clerks with 10 calendar days' notice of all meetings; and
 - CPGs must provide minutes of all meetings.
- 3. Annexe A gives a summary of CPGs compliance with the Code of Conduct Rules.
- 4. Annexe B gives further information on those Groups that have not complied with the rules.

Committee consideration

5. Having considered the information on compliance and membership, the Committee is invited to consider whether it wishes to take any action in relation to non-compliant groups and/or Groups with very low external membership. The Committee could, for example decide to write to the Conveners of Groups for an explanation or invite them in to give evidence to the Committee.

Further information on groups that have not fully complied with the code of conduct

CPGs that have failed to comply with the rules most or all of the time

- 1. There are two Groups in this session that have failed to comply with the Code most of the time.
- 2. The CPG on the Prevention and Healing from Adverse Childhood Experiences experienced a number of MSP resignations which left it unable to hold its AGM. The SPPA Committee agreed at its meeting on 8 December 2022 to withdraw recognition from this cross-party group.
- 3. The CPG on Ireland advised the date of its initial meeting was 28 September 2021 but has not provided any further information since. It has not:
 - held two meetings in the year
 - held its AGM
 - provided the minute of the initial meeting.
- 4. Office-holders were emailed in October 2022 advising of the requirement to hold an AGM, but no response has been received.

CPGs which have partly complied with the rules

Insufficient MSP members and insufficient office bearers

- 5. Section 6, paragraph 8 of the Code requires that each Group has at least 5 MSP members, with at least one MSP member from each of the parties or groups represented on the Parliamentary Bureau. The SPPA Committee agreed a waiver to this rule for Session 6 and all CPGs are required to have at least 5 MSP members, with at least one MSP member from the three of the parties or groups represented on the Parliamentary Bureau.
- 6. A number of CPGs at present are not meeting the above criteria. The resignation of Dean Lockhart as an MSP and the Ministerial appointment of Elena Whitham MSP have left some groups without sufficient MSP members. In addition, due to resignations from a number of CPGs, some were no longer compliant.
- 7. The following table shows those CPGs that are not compliant regarding MSP Membership—

Fewer than two quorate meetings per year

8. Those CPGs that did not hold at least two quorate meetings though out the year are highlighted in the table at Annex A.

AGM not held or held within the specified timeframe

- 9. A number of CPGs have either had to cancel their AGM or experienced difficulty arranging a date for their AGM due to a number of factors.
- 10. Firstly, the passing of HM Queen Elizabeth II in September 2022 saw the UK observe a 10-day period of national mourning. As a result, a number of CPGs had to cancel scheduled business in this period. In addition, due to rail strikes and late business being scheduled at short notice in the Chamber on a number of occasions, some meetings and AGMs had to be cancelled.
- 11. The following CPGs held their AGMs at the incorrect time. An asterix denotes those CPGs which have been affected by the disruptions. All Groups have all been reminded of the requirements in the Code to hold the AGM within 11-13 months of the initial meeting, or previous AGM—
